I am a researcher at the Norwegian Centre for Child Behavioural Development, and received my PhD in motivational psychology at the University of Oslo in 2008 (supervisor: Professor Torgrim Gjesme). My research interests are primarily in examining the interface between personality, motivation, cognition and behavior. I have served as a reviewer for journals as Journal of Adolescent, Personality and Individual Differences, Scandinavian Journal of Educational Research among others. Currently I am working with four research topics:

- 1. Motivation and temporal distance
- 2. Reinforcement sensitivity theory and motivation and antisocial behaviour
- 3. Development and prevention of antisocial behavior, childhood behavior problems, and psychopathology.
- 4. Mediators and moderators of the approach and avoidance performance relationship. The research are represented in journals as Personality and Individual Differences, Educational and Psychological Measurements, and as a book chapter in Contemporary Motivation Research. Moreover, it have resulted in presentations at internationals conferences in the field of clinical psychiatry, criminology, applied psychology, and educational psychology.
