accept submissions for papers and posters. Submissions should be done by sending a

written summary in APA style (American Psychological Association), 6th edition, to the

following email address: simpsi@fpce.up.pt. The abstract should not exceed 300 words

and should include the following information:

• Introduction, objectives, methodology, results and conclusions (do not include quota-

tions nor references)

Submission can be done in Portuguese or English.

The scientific and organizing committees of the SimPsi have the right to decide the final

format (oral presentation or poster), informing the participants in advance on the ac-

ceptance or rejection of the submissions.

Abstract: Authors should use this file as model for submissions for the I SimPsi Abstract Book. Font size 12. Simple line spacing. Justify text. No indented paragraphs. Page layout

should be with 2.5cm. Abstracts should follow APA guidelines (6th edition).

**Keywords**: Maximum 5, Times New Roman, size 12, line spacing 1.5 justify, use semi-

colon (;) between words.

## **Abstracts evaluation**

Revision process will be made by specialists and it will have the following criteria:

- 1. Inovation and relevance
- 2. Clarity of information
- 3. Concise and objective description
- 4. Adequacy of the used methodology
- 5. Adequacy of interpretation

## **Posters guidelines**

All Posters must be submitted in vertical format Ao. It should include: title, names and affiliations of the authors, a theoretical background, assumptions or investigation questions, methodology, results and conclusions.

The title should reflect the content of the poster and match the summary.

The presentation of posters will take up to 60 minutes. This time is dedicated to the display of the posters and the discussion with the authors.
